## **NOMADS RULES & REGULATIONS**

As a member of our unique club, you will be expected to fulfil certain obligations in terms of the rules and regulations as set out in our constitution.

The following points are therefore included to assist you in deciding whether you are able to meet these commitments:

### **WHAT IS NOMADS?**

Nomads is a gathering of golfers who get together once a month and through the game of golf:

1. Cement friendships with golfers with whom we would not ordinarily play.

2. Promote the game of golf.
3. Generate funds for distribution to charities selected by members.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

The prerequisite for induction as a Botswana Nomad is that you need to complete the application form after you show intent to join after playing as a guest. The applicant will then play 3 Nomad monthly games within six months and 1 game with a committee member and your sponsor. Further, that you shall be, and shall remain, a full member of a recognised Golf Club affiliated to the World Amateur Golf Council or the PGA and you must be handicapped by that Golf Club. **In addition, you must participate in, at least, six monthly meetings during the calendar year, and in, at least 50% of the remaining games of the year, after your induction game.** (It is however, common practice for most Nomads to participate in all twelve monthly games). Your standing as a "good" Nomad is largely determined by your attendance at monthly meetings, our AGM and the occasional special event.

## **FINANCIAL COMMITMENT**

The entrance fee is P 3200 and includes the subscription P 600 per annum, playing kit with cap, prize giving Blazer and longs including all gongs and name badges.

When you are inducted, you will be invoiced pro-rata for the year. It would appear that for such a small fee this is a reasonable club to belong to.

There are monthly competition entry fees payable at the golf club hosting the competition.

In addition, the lowest scorer in each four ball is fined P20.00 and then there are fines for misdemeanours. (Sometimes you are lucky and you are not fined at all).

Early leavers, not attending prize giving, have to pay a P50 fine to the scorer to excuse themselves.

## **PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE SPONSOR OF A PROSPECTIVE NOMAD**

1. **As the SPONSOR, you are responsible to invite your guest to ONE OR MORE Nomads monthly games.**
2. **If the GUEST shows intent to join, the SPONSOR is then responsible to complete the application form with the APPLICANT and hand it in to the MEMBERSHIP OFFICER and pay the P 3200 subscription fee.**
3. **The APPLICANT must then play a minimum of THREE (3) GAMES within SIX (6) MONTHS and the FOURTH (4<sup>th</sup>) GAME with a COMMITTEE MEMBER AND HIS SPONSOR.**
4. **The APPLICANT will be announced after his 3<sup>rd</sup> game at prize giving to allow NOMADS for possible objections.**
5. **The APPLICANT will then be inducted as a NOMAD and handed his kit at PRIZEGIVING.**
6. **AS THE SPONSOR, IT IS IMPORTANT TO GIVE YOUR APPLICANT ALL THE IMPORTANT INFORMATION BELOW.**
7. **IMPORTANT: As a SPONSOR you are responsible for your NOMAD throughout his NOMADIC career.**

*Note: ALL Drawn prizes will ONLY go to members attending prize giving.*

In addition, all individual scores count towards Annual Competitions culminating at our Gold Cup Meeting in December.

## **WHERE DO THE FUNDS GO?**

All funds collected are distributed to various charities or to support the game of golf. These funds are distributed annually.

## **SPECIAL EVENTS**

In order to further our aims and objectives, the Committee arrange additional functions, such as dinner/dances and away trips, participation being entirely voluntary.

Besides the normal competition fees, you would be responsible for all travel, accommodation and entertainment costs. Wives/partners are welcome to join you on these trips.

It is at these functions and trips that one really experiences the true fellowship of Nomads.

### **BOTSWANA NATIONAL TOURNAMENT**

Our National Tournament is held once a year, around July to August. A venue is decided upon by the National Coordinator for that year and the choice is between Phakalane Golf Estate or Gaborone Golf Club. The field comprises of around 250 players from South Africa, Botswana, Swaziland, Zambia and Zimbabwe. This is a 2 playing day's event which makes it very attractive to all Nomads visiting and local.

Participation in the National event is entirely voluntary, but anyone who has attended a National Tournament will tell you that this is the highlight of the Nomadic calendar. The cost involved in entering the National tournament normally runs at around P 1,500 per player.

### **VICE CAPTAIN FUNDRAISING ENDOWMENT FUND**

This is our major charity effort of the year when we endeavour to raise a substantial sum for the benefit of a pre-selected charity by the Vice Captain.

Many Nomad members (or their firms) sponsor holes; others donate cash and prizes and most endeavour to play in the golf tournament.

You as a Nomad could be called upon to do something other than Golf by way of time and effort to assist the Committee in achieving their objectives.

You will also be requested to assist in the selling of Raffle books in aid of the fund.

### **HANDICAPS AND RULES OF PLAY**

As a prospective member, you may not play at a Nomads meeting off a handicap higher than your current Club handicap.

With regard to marking of cards, indicate only the gross score for player and marker (yourself) together with the applicable gross stableford points in each instance. Your full Nomads handicap is then added on at the end.

### **GENERAL**

Nomads do not have a course or clubhouse of their own and we are, therefore, dependent upon the generosity of the various Golf Clubs in our area in extending to us the facilities of their courses.

Over the past years Nomads have built up a proud image and accordingly should at all times be conscious of their dress and behaviour, both on and off the course. It must always be remembered that we are guests at the Clubs where we play.

The official dress at all Nomads functions and prizegivings is long dark navy trousers, dark navy blue blazer with Nomads pocket badge, with a plain white shirt, Nomads tie and the name badge presented to you at your induction. On the course, the Nomads dress is the official Nomads shirt and trousers - white Nomads golf shirt, navy blue trousers (or shorts) and official Nomads socks - these are available at the Nomads meetings from the Nomads trailer usually parked close to either the first or tenth tee. Neil Withey is currently responsible for your entire playing and dress kit.

Nomads are **expected** to stay for prizegiving. However, if under **exceptional** circumstances you are unable to stay, a **fine of**

**P 50** must be paid to the to the score card collectors when handing in you score, who will record your apologies. You must understand that you will not be eligible for any drawn prizes should your name come up in the draw if you do not attend prize giving. These prizes will be redrawn or forfeited and used towards our Vice Captains` Fundraising Golf Day.
